

# About AgriLink:

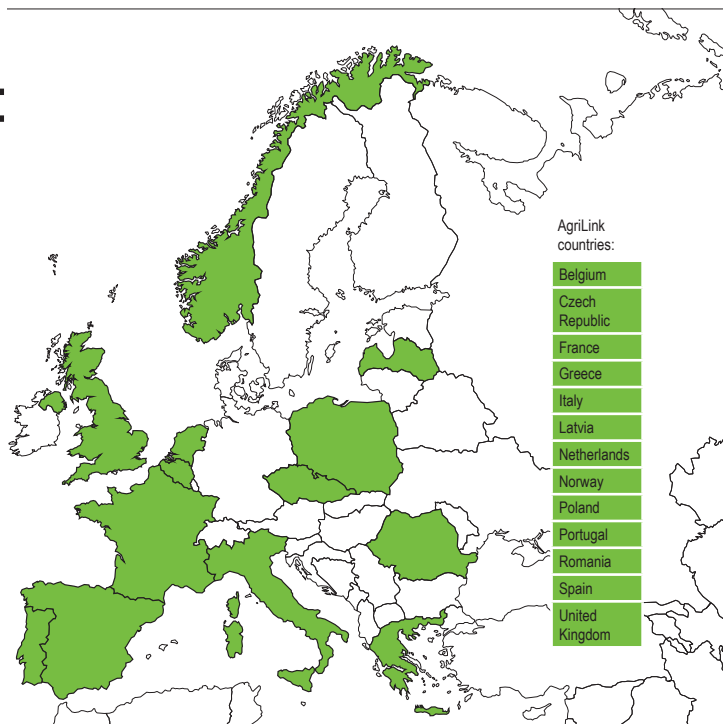
